Dear Fellow Retiree:

As Kaiser Aluminum is attempting to pull together all the pieces of a proposed plan of reorganization, the Bankruptcy Judge has issued an order reactivating the Official Salaried Retirees' Committee, under Section 1114 of the Bankruptcy Code. The members of the retirees' committee are the same as those originally approved by the Bankruptcy Court earlier in the Chapter 11 process. They are: Jess Erickson, Jim Hobby, Dave Perry, Tim Preece, and me.

We met with representatives of Kaiser Aluminum on August 26 in San Francisco. The company representatives shared a large amount of information with the retirees' committee members and, as is normal for meetings at which confidential information about a company and its operations are shared, all of the participants signed confidentiality agreements covering the subjects discussed. I can report that members of the retirees' committee had the opportunity to ask a lot of questions.

The meeting was an informational one. No proposals were made by either the company or the retirees' committee.

We agreed to meet again on September 23.

We will continue to keep you informed.

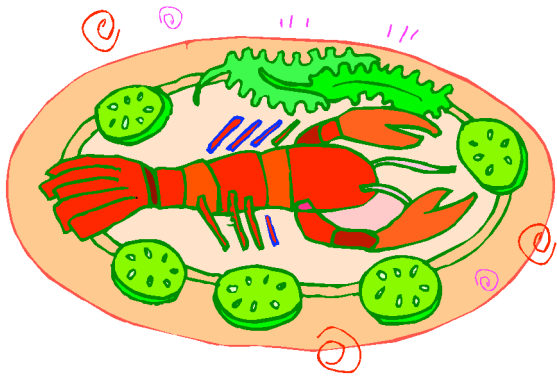
